### FACILITY USE RULES & LIST OF FACILITIES

#### RULES AND REGULATIONS

The Town of Middletown operates several beaches and parks for residents and visitors to enjoy. If you are interested in reserving the use of Town property, please print out and complete rEApplication found on the Town's website at <http://www.middletownri.com>. To insure that you and your guests have a memorable visit, please obey the following rules and regulations when using Town facilities:

1. The following fees (Town Ordinance Chapter 36 Section 52) apply for reserving Town beaches or parks:

Middletown Resident/Non-Profit

1. Peak Season: June 1st – September 30th - \$100 per day

2. Non-Peak Season: October 1st – May 31st - \$50 per day

Non-Resident/Commercial \*

1. Peak Season: June 1st – September 30th - \$200 per day

2. Non-Peak Season: October 1st – May 31st - \$100 per day

\* Wellness/Recreation Camps: \$10 per day usage fee in addition to Special Event Permit Fee (Please see special restrictions and requirements that apply to Wellness/Recreation Camps at <http://www.middletownri.com/government/6/44/Special-Event-Facility-Use-Permits>).

2. No drinking of alcoholic beverages at any of the Town of Middletown operated parks, beaches, playgrounds or athletic fields. The Middletown police will enforce the Town ordinance against public drinking.

3. No loud music or noise per the Town's noise ordinance

4. Authorized activities or sports must take place in designated areas only.

5. Vehicles must park legally using available parking spaces. Usual summer parking fees apply for Second and Third Beach parking lots. All parking lots must be cleared within ½ hour of the time when the gathering is scheduled to end. Any vehicles left in lot will be towed at owner's expense. The Town does not provide parking at the Dunlap Wheeler Park, so parking for any event at that location must make other parking plans.

6. No overnight sleeping on town beaches or parks.

7. Litter must be picked up after the event, and depending on location trash must be placed in receptacles or carried out.

8. Any keys issued must be returned to the Department of Public Works within 48 hours after use.

<b>Berkeley Peckham Field</b>	Green End Ave	Baseball field, bathrooms, free parking
<b>Demery Memorial Park</b>	Riverview Ave	Large field, views of the Sakonett River, limited parking
<b>Dunlap Wheeler Park</b>	Purgatory Rd	Ocean side, limited parking
<b>Howland Park</b>	Wapping Rd	Basketball court, floor hockey court, shade structure, grills, playground, port-a-potty, free parking
<b>Linden Park</b>	West Main Rd	Playground, sports field, port potty, free parking
<b>Paradise Valley Park</b>	Prospect Ave	Historical windmill, walking trail, shade structure, free parking, picnic tables, bike rack
<b>Potsy Field</b>	West Main Rd	Softball field with lights, basketball court, bathrooms, free parking, bike rack
<b>Sachuest Point Beach (Second Beach)</b>	Sachuest Point Rd	Seasonal public beach, pay to park, bathrooms, showers, concession stand, bike racks, shade structures, picnic tables, grills, port-a-potties
<b>Third Beach</b>	Third Beach Rd	Seasonal public beach, pay to park, port-a-potties, shade structures, bike rack, boat ramp, picnic tables, grills, kayak rack and moorings
<b>Wyatt Road Soccer Complex</b>	Wyatt Rd	Soccer fields, shade structure, access to walking trails, port-a-potty, free parking
